

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE HALLOCK CITY COUNCIL
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2022**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Dave Treumer called the special meeting of the Hallock City Council to order at 4:09 pm on October 28, 2022. Those Present: Mayor Dave Treumer, Mike Totleben, Naomi Larson, Jennifer Peterson and Kevin Waller.

Also present: City Clerk-Administrator Aimee Sugden, Utility Superintendent Dan Larson and Kittson County Enterprise Reporter Anna Jauhola.

APPROVE AGENDA

Councilor Waller motioned to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilor Totleben and carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Totleben moved to approve the minutes of the special Hallock City Council Meeting on October 24, 2022. The motion was seconded by Councilor Waller and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Statement from Mayor Treumer

Mayor Treumer read a prepared statement to the council.

Hiring a Maintenance Worker

Motion by Councilor Waller to hire K. Dorion as a full-time maintenance worker. The motion was seconded by Mayor Treumer and failed by a 2-2-1 vote with Councilor Peterson abstaining.

Motion by Councilor Larson to hire J. Turner as a full-time maintenance worker. The motion was seconded by Councilor Totleben and carried by a 3-1-1 vote with Councilor Peterson abstaining.

Motion by Councilor Larson to start pay for J. Turner at Year 2 (COLA eligible) and be eligible for a review and raise to the next step after 6-months. The motion was seconded by Councilor Totleben and carried by a 3-0-1 vote with Councilor Peterson abstaining.

Councilor Waller asked Utility Superintendent Larson about a plaque to recognize TC Energy for their donation to the playground. Larson and Sugden will follow-up.
